ARTS & CRAFT VENDOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement is between the Shoshone-Bannock Festival Committee (Vendor's Name) _____ . There will be no solicitation for the sale of Arts and Craft or other items without proper payment of booth fee to the Festival Committee. This includes walking vendors.

1. Vendors are responsible to provide documentation of Tribal Enrollment or Census number **prior** to acceptance of application by the Festival Committee.
2. There are approximately 50 (10x10) covered booths available. **Which Will Be On A First Paid, First Space Assigned Basis.** These booths will be provided with lighting and two outlets. Air conditioning systems and personal generators are not allowed.
3. Approximately 20 open standard spaces (10x20) are available on the festival grounds, **Also On A First Paid, First Space Assigned Basis.** These booths will not be provided with any lighting, but two power outlets will be provided.
4. **No Payment arrangements will be made; BOOTHS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE A NUMBER IS ASSIGNED.**
5. There is NO RV hookups, no power for polishing machine, small appliances, etc. available at the festival grounds.
6. Limited Power is available and you must furnish your own extension cords. United Laboratory (UL) rating must be on all electric cords and surge protectors (if used), to avoid any electrical fires. Booths will use electricity wisely and not over load circuits. Generator are recommended incase of power failure.
7. Daily inspections will take place during the festival by the Fort Hall Fire District & Festival Committee, if a vendor is in non-compliance:
 - Verbal warning given
 - Written warning given and a fine of \$100.00
 - Escorted off the Festival Grounds and possible prosecuted in tribal courts
8. Vendor cannot allow another vendor (part/individual) to set up in their booths unless (party/individual) is listed on application and signed agreement.
9. REFUND, allowed only if the Festival Committee receives a written notice of cancellation request in writing for a full refund by July 31st, 2010. There will be absolutely no refunds due to natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise throughout the festival.
10. **Depending upon Availability,** *if an application is received after July 31st, 2010, there will be a late charge of \$50.00.*

General Information

1. Vendors must maintain a clean environment in and around booth area!
2. Vendors will be issued only 1 vehicle pass.
3. Beaded items for sale must be Authentic Native American made, **NO IMITATIONS** from other countries.
4. No selling of Food (consumable items or drinks) at Arts & Craft vendor booths or camp ground area.
5. No selling on festival grounds of Pirated or unauthorized filming of powwows, on DVD's & CD's!
6. No walking vendor's are allowed on the Festival Grounds.
7. **Consumption of any alcoholic beverages or use of illegal drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED! It is the Vendors responsibility to enforce this policy among his/her employees and associates.**

Vendors violating any of the conditions shall be immediately subject to cancellation of the agreement and will be escorted from the premises by local law enforcement, merchandise items will be confiscated and possible prosecuted in tribal courts.

I understand that The Fort Hall Indian Reservation is an Alcohol/Drug free reservation; therefore vendors shall not consume or be in possession of any alcohol/drugs in and around the Festival Grounds. Vendors who are intoxicated or in possession of alcohol/drugs shall be turned over to local law enforcement and removed from the grounds.

I understand that this application does not guarantee any liability from the Shoshone-Bannock Festival Committee nor *The Shoshone-Bannock Tribes* for natural catastrophes or weather conditions that should arise or for accidents, fires, theft or any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Festival Committee or *The Shoshone-Bannock Tribes*
