







# SHOSHONE-BANNOCK TRIBES 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR CLOTHING APPLICATIONS



The Tribal Youth Education Program is accepting applications for school clothing assistance. **Applications will be accepted Starting August 2, 2021 until funds have been depleted.**

-  Tribal Youth Education Program is now located at the Old Lillian Vallely School 350 S 700 W Blackfoot, Idaho. Wear a mask and maintain the 6ft social distancing.
-  Student must be an enrolled member of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes.
-  Student must be **REGISTERED & Physically attend** a public, charter or private school grades K-12.
-  Due to limited funding online or home school is not covered under this funding.
-  **Parent/Guardian must provide documentation (CIB or Tribal I.D.) for proof of enrollment for each student listed on application.**
-  Application must be completed, signed and on file with the Tribal Youth Education Program. If further federal education forms are needed for your student you will be notified before payment is processed. ***INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED FOR CONSIDERATION.*** Due to limited funding, school clothing assistance will only be issued on a ***first-come, first-serve basis*** to eligible applicants, until the funds are depleted. Students without direct deposit will receive a paper check in the mail.

Clothing checks will be issued to eligible Tribal member students grades K-12. Funding is LIMITED and assistance is on a first-come first-serve basis. We will issue clothing checks until the funds are depleted.

**Applications will be accepted STARTING August 2, 2021.**

- Enrolled Shoshone Bannock Tribal members that receive school clothing checks must **PERSONALLY** appear. Under special accommodations can be made on an individual case by case circumstance. Exceptions are made for the out of state/area tribal member students.
- Applicant **MUST** be the Custodial Parent and/or Legal Guardian with primary physical custody of the Tribal member student applying for assistance. Signatures on paperwork need to be from the legal guardian.
- No notes, letters, power of attorney, proxies, or similar letters of assignment or representation will be accepted.
- **Lost or stolen school clothing checks will NOT be reissued.**
- Home schooled/Online students do not qualify for funding, as they are at a home setting.
- There will be no exceptions to the above distribution policies.
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU UPDATE YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS WITH TRIBAL ENROLLMENT** . If your student does not receive direct deposit the address tribal enrollment has on file is where the paper checks will be mailed.
- All applicants are responsible to abide by the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes Policy, violations may result in a **void of your check and may impact future benefits.**
