BURN PERMIT ISSUED ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY

DRAW MAP WITH ROAD, LOCATION & NEAREST CROSS ROAD

FOR THE PURPOSE OF WEED ABATEMENT, BRUSH OR TRASH DISPOSAL IN DITCHES, CANALS, GARDENS OR YARDS, AND HAY MEADOW ASSIGNMENTS, THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS SHALL APPLY:

APPROVAL TO BURN

1. **BEFORE** you burn, notify the Fort Hall Fire Department at **(208) 478-3784 or 3783**
2. NO FIRES SHALL BE IGNITED BEFORE 7:00A.M. AND BURN NO LATER THAN 1/2 HOUR BEFORE SUNSET OR 8:00P.M.
3. ALL FIRES SHALL BE EXTINGUISHED BEFORE SUNSET.
4. **NO** BURNING SHALL BE DONE UNDER WINDY, EXTREMELY DRY, OR HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS, OR CONDITIONS OF POOR SMOKE DISPERSION.
5. **FOR EMERGENCIES ONLY! CALL THE FORT HALL POLICE DEPARTMENT AT 238-4000.**

MATERIAL

6. THE MATERIAL BURNED UNDER THIS PERMIT SHALL NOT CONTAIN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIAL: BONES, RUBBER, PLASTIC, DEAD ANIMALS, ASPHALT, TAR PAPER, ANY ROOFING MATERIALS, INSULATED WIRE, JUNK VEHICLES, FERTILIZERS, PESTICIDES, INSECTICIDES, GRAIN SEEDS, PAINT, OIL, GAS, DIESEL FUEL. THE MATERIAL BURNED MUST NOT BE TOO WET OR TOO COMPACT CAUSING POOR SMOKE DISPERSION.

PERMISSION

7. NO PERSON SHALL KINDLE A FIRE UPON THE LAND OF ANOTHER WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE OWNER, THEREOF, OR HIS AGENT.

LOCATION RESTRICTED

8. NO PERSON SHALL KINDLE OR MAINTAIN ANY BON FIRE OR RUBBISH FIRE OR AUTHORIZE ANY FIRE TO BE KINDLED OR MAINTAINED ON ANY PRIVATE LAND UNLESS (1) THE LOCATION IS NOT LESS THAN FIFTY FEET FROM ANY STRUCTURE AND ADEQUATE PROVISION IS MADE TO PREVENT FIRE FROM SPREADING TO WITHIN FIFTY FEET FROM ANY STRUCTURE (2) THE FIRE IS CONTAINED IN ANY APPROVED WASTE BURNER SAFELY NOT MORE THAN FIFTY FEET FROM ANY STRUCTURE.
9. NO PERSON SHALL KINDLE A FIRE UPON GRAZING LAND, FOREST RESERVES OR ANY WILDLAND AREAS. .

HAYMEADOW ASSIGNMENTS

10. BURNING OF HAYMEADOW OR FEEDLOTS IS RESTRICTED FROM OCTOBER 1 TO MAY 1, OF EACH YEAR.
11. BURN ONLY THOSE AREAS IN THE HAYMEADOW OR FEEDLOT CONTAINING WILDHAY ONLY. DO NOT BURN BULL BRUSH, WILLOWS, ROSEBUSH AND TREES.
12. DO NOT BURN WITHIN 25 FEET OF ANY STREAMS OR CREEKS.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

SHOSHONE-BANNOCK LAW & ORDER CODE, CHAPTER XVI, CRIMINAL CODE, SECTION 40, UNATTENDED FIRES

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO SET FIRE TO ANY GRASS, PASTURE BRUSH, RANGE DITCH, WOODLAND, OR STRUCTURE AND LEAVE SUCH FIRE UNATTENDED OR OTHERWISE SET ANY FIRE LIKELY TO CREATE ALARM OR LEAD OTHERS TO BELIEVE THAT SUCH FIRE IS UNATTENDED OR UNCONTROLLED. WITHOUT, PRIOR TO IGNITION OR SETTING OF SUCH FIRE, NOTIFYING DISPATCHER OF THE SHOSHONE-BANNOCK POLICE DEPARTMENT.

ANY PERSON FOUND GUILTY OF AN OFFENSE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE SENTENCED TO A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT NOT TO EXCEED SIX (6) MONTHS, OR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 (FIVE-HUNDRED DOLLARS) AND/OR 6 MONTHS IN JAIL, AND RESTITUTION FOR ALL COSTS ACCRUED FOR SUPPRESSION.
