<b>Permit Procedures</b>	The Land Use Policy Commission through the Land Use Ordinance has regulations governing the control of signs, billboards, and advertisements on the Fort Hall Reservation in Article 1 § 2 of the Land Use Ordinance. The regulations of signs, billboards, and advertisements also apply to political posters, signs or announcements placed by any political candidates as stated in § 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Land Use Operative Policy Guidelines, Chapter V-V8 "signs". <i>(please initial below)</i>	
	A sign permit must be paid and approved of by the Land Use Policy Commission <u>PRIOR</u> to the sign(s) being installed.	
	Any landowners who allow or place signs on their property must secure the permit <u>PRIOR</u> to the sign being installed.	
	Permit filing fee of \$30 payable to the Land Use Department, must accompany application.	
	Political advertisements must be removed by the politician <u>within 20 days following the election</u> ; a penalty of \$10 per day will be applied, up to \$100.	
	No political signs will be posted at any Tribal entities (Enterprise, Casino, Hotel, Tribal Buildings, etc.).	
	Political signs shall NOT be placed within 200 feet of any polling location.	
	All signs for advertisement must be renewed annually.	
	If the sign permit is not approved and paid for <u>PRIOR</u> to the sign(s) being installed, the sign(s) will be removed immediately.	

	Signs must not obstruct traffic at any time or they will be removed.
	No sign shall be placed on private property, unless authorized by the landowner.
	Permit number must be displayed on each sign in the lower right-hand corner of the sign.

**Legal Authority**

**JURISDICTION:** In the event a Shoshone-Bannock Tribal Permit is granted, I (we) will comply with all Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and do hereby submit to the jurisdiction provided for therein and shall abide by all laws; and CERTIFY that I (we) are authorized as an owner, partner, corporate representative to sign this document and that the statements made are correct to the best of my knowledge, I (we) also acknowledge that by our signature, I (we) are to be held responsible for the actions and execution of this permit while upon the Fort Hall Indian Reservation.
